

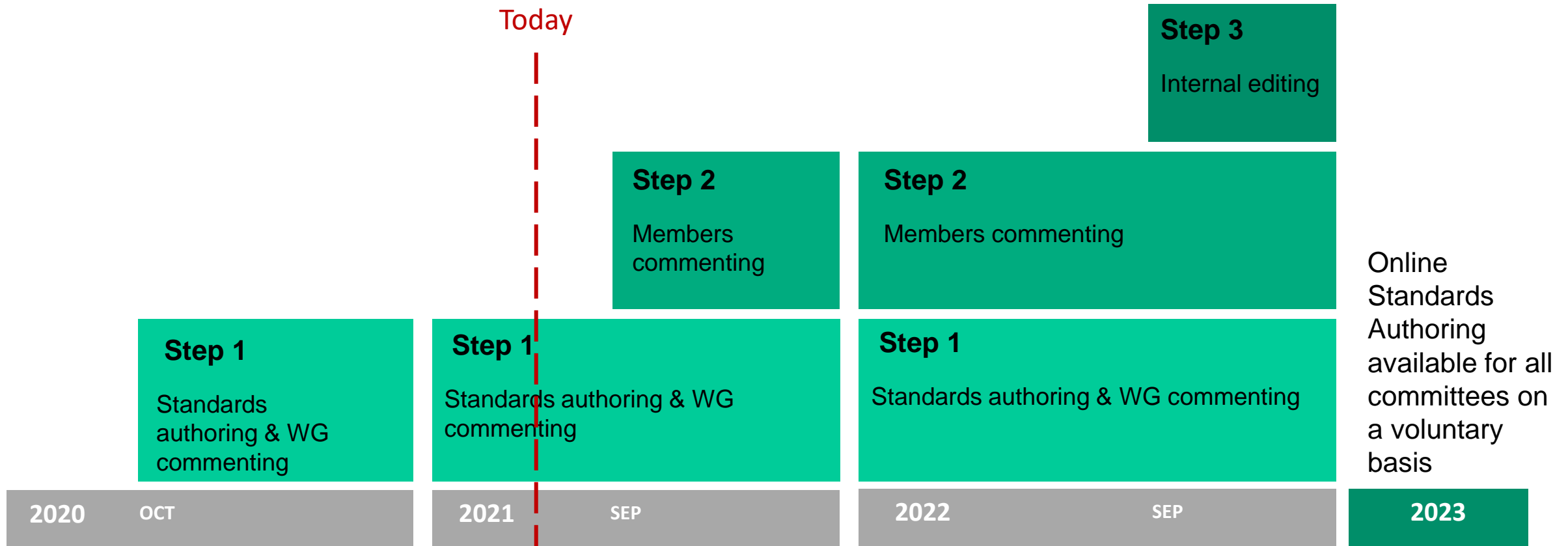




Today



The new tool

- ▶ Word-like
- ▶ Browser-based
- ▶ Built on FontoXML
- ▶ Customized for our environment
 - ▶ Document structure
 - ▶ Normative references
 - ▶ Comment tagging
 - ▶ Numbering
 - ▶ Roles & permissions
 - ▶ Quality checks
 - ▶ EU directives annexes (ZA/ZZ)
 - ▶ Etc...

The pilots so far

- ▶ **5** Pilot groups involved:
 - ▶ 278552 – CEN/TC 278 Intelligent Transport Systems
 - ▶ 442027 – CEN/TC 442 Building Information Modelling
 - ▶ prEN_50708-1-1 – CLC/TC 14 Power Transformers
 - ▶ prEN_50716 – CLC/TC 9X Railways
 - ▶ prEN_1994-1-2 – CEN/TC 250 Eurocodes
- ▶  Positive (but very limited) feedback
- ▶  Very low usage, mostly due to timing of drafting
- ▶  Some feature requests from the pilot groups
- ▶  Quarterly releases with new features
- ▶  Export to Word once done (for now)

Call for participation

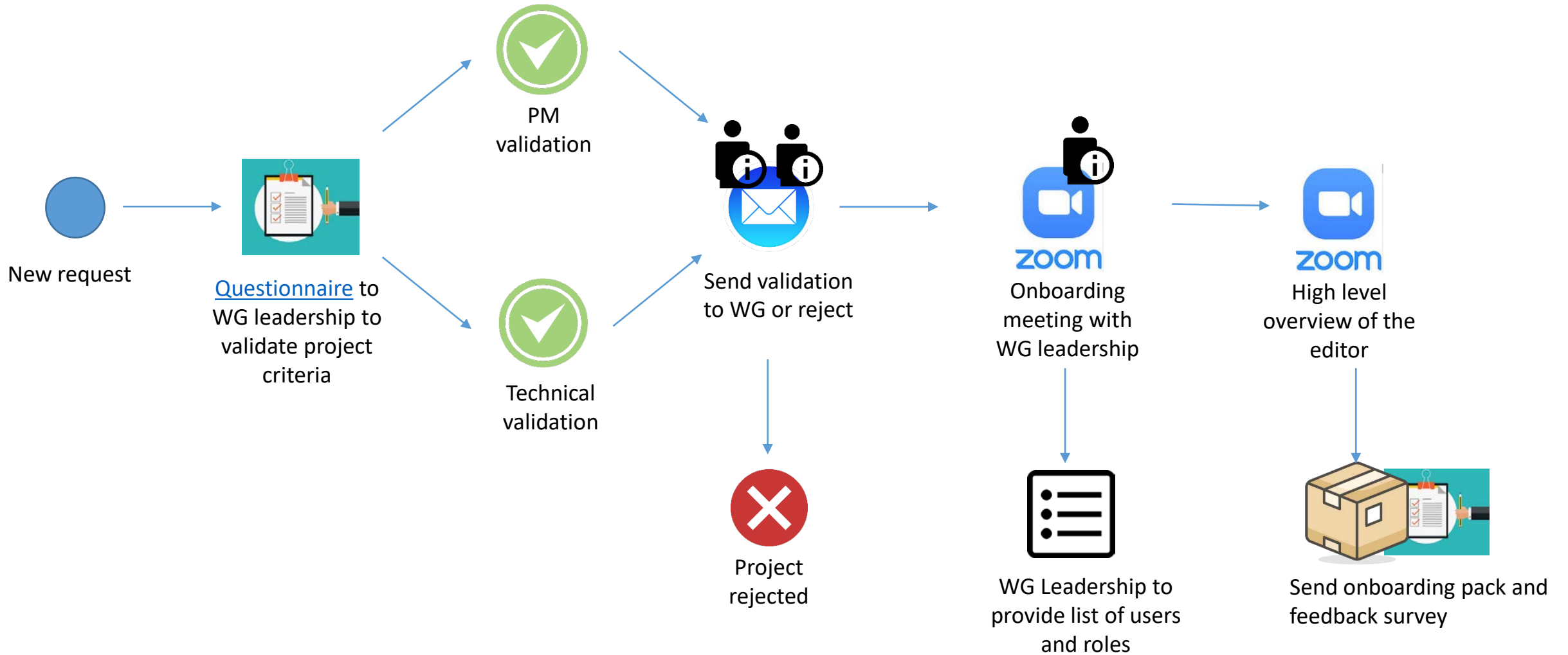
We are looking for groups that...

- ✓ Will draft (most) content directly in the new tool
- ✓ Will start drafting in the next few months
- ✓ Have a “pilot” mindset
 - ✓ Understand not all is perfect and workarounds may be required
 - ✓ Will proactively give feedback & make suggestions
 - ✓ Will answer occasional surveys
- ✓ ALL group members will work in the new tool (with different access levels)

But we don't need groups that...

- × Already created all content
- × Will draft in Word and then copy to the new tool
- × Will start drafting in 6+ months
- × Some group members will only work in Word


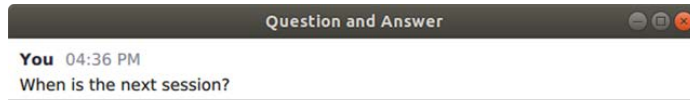
