1. CEN NSB Membership Fees

a. Fee Calculation Methodology

The Total amount of NSBs membership fees is allocated between all Members based on a financial contribution percentage calculated for each NSB individually.

Each financial contribution percentage is obtained by the combination of the country GNI and Population percentages, with a correction factor applied to the latter.

GNI and Population percentages obtained are weighting respectively 30% and 70% in the financial contribution percentage, considering that the Lisbon Treaty is using the Population as main criteria.

The correction factors applied to the Population percentage are as follows:

% Country Population in total European Population	Correction Factor
>10 %	1,1
>7,5 %	1,3
>2,5 %	1,5
>1,0 %	2,0
>0,5 %	2,2
>0,3 %	3,0
>0,10 %	4,0
<0,10 %	10,0

b. Annual application of the fee calculation methodology

- CCMC will review, each year as of 30th August, the GNI and the Population from every Member Country according to the latest GNI and Population data figures available on the World Bank website ^{1 2}:
 - i. For each member, the updated GNI and Population data will be listed in the membership fee calculation spreadsheet;
 - ii. if needed, the correcting factor associated to the Member updated Population will be adjusted accordingly based on the table listed above under 1.a;

- iii. The total GNI and Population data for each Member will also be updated (to allow calculation of the percentage of a country GNI and Population in the total European respective one);
- iv. The necessary total NSBs membership fees will be determined in the budget preparation and agreed by CEN AG as part of the CEN budget approval process.

- Each year, as part of the annual budget preparation, CCMC will:
 - i. Determine the operational revenue and expenses budget for CEN;
 - ii. Determine the EC/EFTA funding taking into account the policy concerning the financial dependence of CEN on EC/EFTA funding;
 - iii. Determine the total NSBs membership fees necessary to balance the CEN budget, update necessary data and calculate the membership fees (in Euros) for each NSB;
 - iv. Submit to CEN/CACC FIN for review the updated data and calculated membership fees.
- The membership fees will then be included in the CEN budget to be approved by the CEN AG in November.

2. CENELEC NC Membership Fees

a. Fee Calculation Methodology

The number of financial units associated to a country depends on the number of votes per country defined by the Nice Treaty, and a correction factor linked to the Gross National Income (GNI).

For a country not defined by the Nice Treaty, the number of financial units will be obtained by comparing its GNI (and Population) to a 'similar' country defined by the Nice Treaty.

The correction factors applied to the GNI percentage are as follows:

% Country GNI in total European GNI	Correction Factor
>10 %	1,25
5 – 10 %	1,5
2 – 5 %	1,75
1 – 2 %	2,0
0,4 – 1 %	2,5
0,15 – 0,4 %	2,75
<0,15 %	3,0

b. Annual application of the fee calculation methodology

- CCMC will review, each year as of 30th August, the GNI from every Member Country according to the latest GNI data figures available on the World Bank website ³:
 - i. For each member, the updated GNI data will be listed in the membership fee calculation spreadsheet;
 - ii. if needed, the correcting factor associated to the Member updated GNI will be adjusted accordingly;
 - iii. The total GNI data for each Member will also be updated (to reflect any change in the percentage of a country GNI in the total European one).

- Each year, as part of the annual budget preparation, CCMC will:
 - i. Determine the operational revenue and expenses budget for CENELEC;
 - ii. Determine the financial unit to obtain the total membership fees necessary to balance the CENELEC budget, update necessary data and calculate the individual membership fees (in Euros) for each NC;
 - iii. Submit to CENELEC/FINPOL for review the updated data and calculated membership fees.
- The membership fees will then be included in the CENELEC budget to be approved by the CENELEC AG in November.

3. Affiliates and Companion Standardization Bodies (CSB) Fees

a. Fee Calculation Methodology

As stated in CEN-CENELEC Guides 12 (Affiliation) and 13 (CSB), the Affiliate and CSB annual fee are linked to the GNI interval in which falls the GNI at current prices in US dollars of the country of the (candidate) Affiliate/CSB.

The GNI intervals and corresponding annual fees are as follows:

GNI Intervals (in billion USD)	Annual Fee (€) As from 1 st Jan 2020
< 20	€12.900
20 - 50	€16.125
50 - 100	€21.500
>100	€26.875

b. Annual application of the fee calculation methodology

- CCMC will review, each year, the GNI from every Affiliate and CSB Country according to the latest GNI data figures available as of 30th August on the World Bank website⁴ :
 - i. For each Affiliate/CSB, the updated GNI data will be listed in the affiliates fee calculation spreadsheet;
 - ii. If needed, the correcting factor associated to the Affiliate's/CSB's updated GNI will be adjusted accordingly;

- Each year, as part of the annual budget preparation, CCMC will submit to CEN/CACC FIN and CENELEC/FINPOL for review the updated data and calculated fees (in Euros).
- The fees will then be included in the CEN and CENELEC budgets to be approved by the CEN and CENELEC AGs in November.
- The General Assembly of CEN and/or CENELEC may decide to revise the fee levels and related amounts applicable to Affiliates/CSBs, should inflation or other circumstances justify such a decision.
