Cybersecurity and Data Protection



- Established 2017 by CEN CENELEC BTs
- First meeting Brussels, 2017-11-07
- Second meeting Brussels, 2018-02-14

- CEN-CENELEC JTC 13/WG 1 „Chair Advisory Group“ will carry on the Work of the CEN/CENELEC Cybersecurity Focus Group (the former CSCG)

Proposed Scope* (1/2)

Development of standards for cybersecurity and data protection covering all aspects of the evolving information society, including but not limited to:

- Organizational frameworks and methodologies, including management systems
- Data protection and privacy
- Services and products evaluation standards suitable for security assessment
- Competence requirements for cybersecurity and data protection
- Security requirements, services, techniques and guidelines for ICT systems, services, networks and devices, including smart objects and distributed computing devices

Proposed Scope* (2/2) – *Focus on adoption and harmonization for Europe*

Included in the scope is the identification and possible adoption of documents already published or under development by ISO/IEC JTC 1 and other SDOs and international bodies such as ISO, IEC, ITU-T, IEEE, NIST, and industrial fora.

Where not being developed by other SDO's, the development of cybersecurity and data protection CEN/CENELEC publications for safeguarding information such as organizational frameworks, management systems, techniques, guidelines, and products and services, including those in support of the EU Digital Single Market.

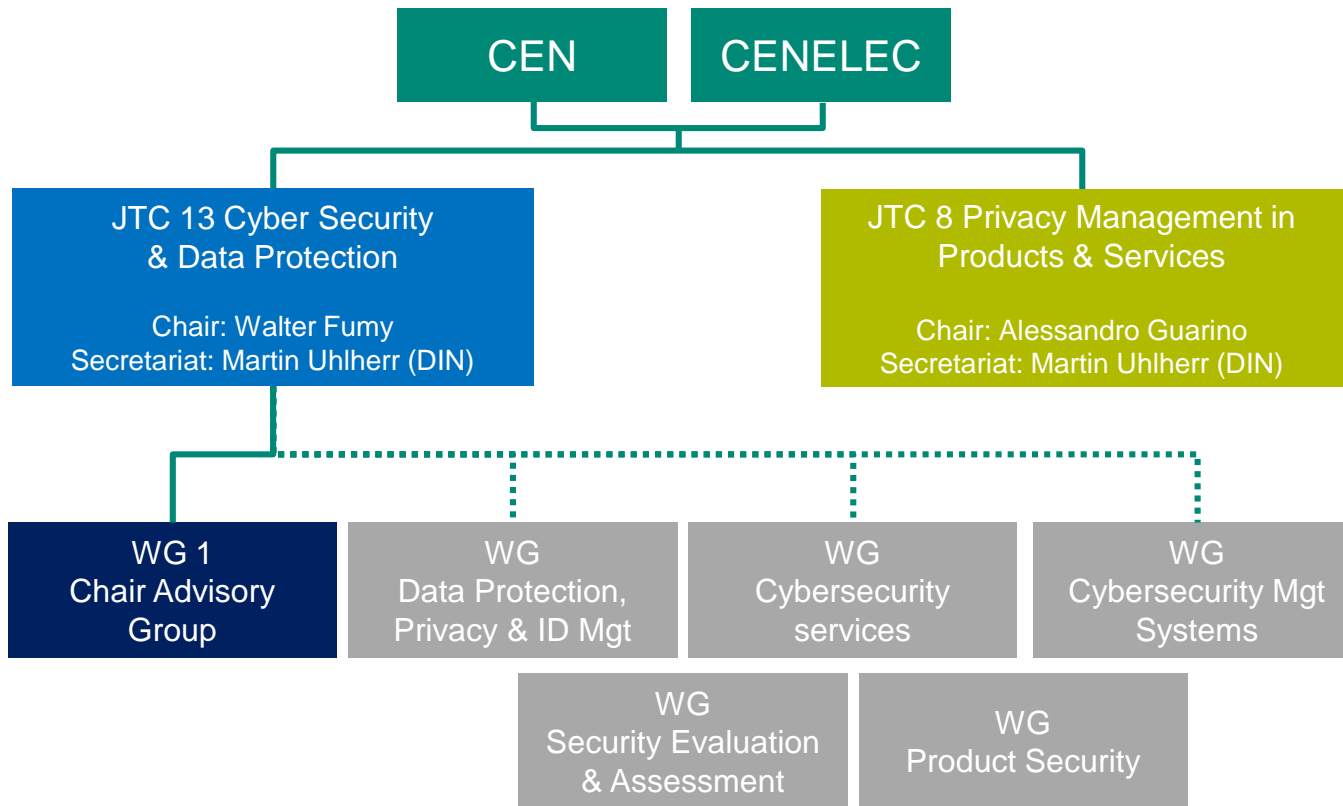

Adoption of other international standards as ENs	3 year timeframe	EN
Development of TRs and TSs supporting the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and based on international standards	3 year timeframe	TR or TS
Development of TRs and TSs supporting the NIS Directive and based on international standards	3 year timeframe	TR or TS
Guidelines and best practices for the European economy on how to implement international cybersecurity and data protection standards by fulfilling EU legislations.	3 year timeframe	TR or TS
